- to obtain from the BCA any record that forms the basis for the report, and
- to challenge the accuracy and completeness of any information contained in the report
- to be informed whether Kinship of the Perham Area has denied your application because of the BCA's response and not to be required directly or indirectly to pay the cost of the background check.
